THE STRATFORD PARK GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES.

1. OUT OF BOUNDS Rule 18-2

- a) Beyond any fence, hedge or line of white markers bounding the course
- b) The hedge on the left of the 9th fairway and all ground to the left of the white stakes leading from that hedge up to the 9th green
- c) The hotel drive and the practice area including that on the right hand side of the lake on the 18th hole

2 OVERHEAD CABLES Rule 14-6

- if it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line (or tower or wire or pole supporting a power line) during the play of holes 13, 14 or 16, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made.

3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS Rule 16

All bridges, permanent paths, sprinkler valve covers, pop-up sprinklers and drain covers, bell posts, signs, ball cleaner posts and temporary metal teeing platforms are immovable obstructions. Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken. For a ball in the General Area (not a hazard) the player may take relief if a sprinkler head is on the line of play, and is within two club-lengths of the putting green and is within two club-lengths of the ball.

4. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS Rule 16

- a) A ball coming to rest in an area designated as ground under repair **MUST** be lifted and dropped without penalty.
- b) Ground under repair may include un-marked areas of unusual damage where vehicle tracks have combined with wet conditions to alter the ground surface materially such as to interfere with the player's area of intended stance or area of intended swing. A ball coming to rest in such tracks may be lifted and dropped without penalty.

Distance markers are to the centre of the green.

- Red Flag front third
- Yellow Flag middle third
- White Flag back third of green
